Amendments to the FY 2021 – 2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

5. Approval of Amendment #13 to the FY 2021-2025 TIP

Amendment #13 to the FY 2021 – 2025 Transportation Improvement Program, consists of an increase in the project amount for project no. CM21-5009 in FY 2021, for partial width resurfacing on I-74/55, under Veteran's Parkway and I-55 NB in Bloomington.

Mr. Neihart noted that this is a contract maintenance project, for a 1.5-inch overlay.

Mr. Aldrich moved for approval of Amendment #13, and was seconded by Mr. Kothe. The motion carried unanimously.

6. Approval of Amendment #14 to the FY 2021-2025 TIP

Amendment #14 to the FY 2021 – 2025 Transportation Improvement Program, consists of the addition of project no. BP 2022-1 in FY 2022, for bridge painting on I-74 at various locations, including four within the MPA, at a total cost of \$760,000 for the structures within the MPO. This is set for a September letting.

Mr. Kothe moved for approval of Amendment #14, and was seconded by Mr. Stokes. The motion carried unanimously.
