1. Call to Order

Ms. Kramp called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

2. <u>Attendance</u>

Attendance by Committee members and proxies was determined and is listed above. A quorum was present.

3. Public Comment

Ms. Sicks advised that no request for public comment was received, and no one is present to offer comment. Ms. Sicks noted that instructions are available for access to virtual meetings and livestreams of the Transportation Committees on agendas and the MCRPC website.

4. <u>Minutes</u>

Mr. Kothe offered a motion to approve the minutes of the December 18, 2020 meeting, and



was seconded by Mr. Soeldner. The motion was unanimously approved.

Items for Action, as recommended for approval by the Technical Committee Amendments to the FY 2021 – 2025 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

5. Approval of Amendment #12 to the FY 2021-2025 TIP

Amendment #12 to the FY 2021 – 2025 Transportation Improvement Program, for Connect Transit, consisting of updated tables for expenses, revenue and funding, and capital projects.

Mr. Lai noted that the amendment reflects increased funding for Connect Transit. Ms. Sicks noted that Connect Transit will use the new funds across several projects, including the acquisition of replacement electric buses and charging infrastructure. There will also be installation of solar power equipment on the Wylie Drive facility.

Ms. Kramp asked if additional local funding would be required to use the additional local funding. Ms. Sicks noted that match requirements may vary according to the grant, but in this TIP all of the required funding is accounted for.

Mr. Otto moved for approval of Amendment #12, and was seconded by Mr. Kothe. The motion carried unanimously.

6. Resolution

The resolution documents the Policy Committee acceptance of the IDOT revised targets for federal performance measures.

Mr. Lai noted that the MPO accepted the first round of performance measures and targets, and advanced by IDOT in October of 2020. The revised measures and targets result from evaluation of performance on targets over the last two years; the revisions have been made to establish targets for the next two years. Ms. Sicks noted that the resolution includes language noting that it is not possible to meet the state targets numerically, due to the difference in population size. The MPO participants will pursue the targets proportionally to assist in the statewide achievement of the targets.

Mr. Soeldner moved for approval of the resolution, and was seconded by Mr. Kothe. The motion carried unanimously.
